8. RESOLUTIONS

- (a.) Resolution No. 1996, a resolution of the City of McMinnville, Tennessee to accept the low bid from Hall's Excavating and Backhoe in the amount of \$18,600.00 for the remediation, demolition and disposal of meth contaminated residential structure located at 131 Higginbotham Road as per specifications of the McMinnville Planning and Zoning Department; to authorize the City Administrator to issue the necessary purchase order; and to express the time when the resolution becomes effective.

- (a.) Ordinance No. 1732, an ordinance of the City of McMinnville, Tennessee, to appropriate funds to certain nonprofit charitable organizations and certain nonprofit civic organizations to promote civic betterment, social improvements and the health and general welfare of the residents of the City of McMinnville and to promote the economic welfare of the City of McMinnville and its residents, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2016 and ending June 30, 2017 in the aggregate amount of \$313,479.00 and to provide the conditions under which the appropriations are made; and to express the time when the ordinance becomes effective.
