- (a.) Resolution No. 2029, a resolution of the City of McMinnville, Tennessee, to accept the low bid of Citizenserve in the amount of \$17,000.00 to provide software and services for an all-in-one cloud based citizen service platform for planning & zoning, building permitting, inspections, property maintenance code enforcement, storm water and floodplain management; to authorize the City Administrator of the City of McMinnville to issue the necessary purchase order on behalf of the City of McMinnville; and to express the time when the resolution becomes effective.
