

GILLEY POOL LIFEGUARD (SEASONAL)

JOB DESCRIPTION

This person is responsible for ensuring the safety of facility patrons by preventing and responding to emergencies. Employees in this class are under general supervision of the Pool Manager. Work performed will be in lifesaving, First Aid and CPR.

KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS

- Must possess minimum lifeguard training:
 - Current American Red Cross Lifeguard Training certificate (YMCA equivalent acceptable)
 - Current American Red Cross Standard First Aid certificate
 - Current American Red Cross CPR for the Professional Rescuer certificate
- Thorough knowledge of proper rescue techniques and proper use of rescue equipment.
- Must be able to perform water rescues, give CPR and First Aid.
- Must understand facility characteristics, rules, policies, and procedures.
- Ability to follow oral and written instructions.
- Ability to maintain an effective working relationship with the public and employees.
- Ability to work flexible hours with evening, weekend and holiday work required.
- Ability to concentrate and accomplish tasks despite interruptions.
- Ability to evaluate situations and make decisions.
- Ability to communicate clearly and effectively.
- Ability to conduct oneself in a professional manner at all times.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

- Recognize and respond effectively in emergencies.
- Enforces swimming pool rules and regulations.
- Monitors all activities in swimming pool.
- Reports any unsafe conditions or equipment to the supervisor.
- Identify and assist patrons in need or having difficulties.
- Helps maintain a cleanliness of the pool deck, bathhouse, and concessions area, in the pool, outside the pool gate, and the pool office area.
- Assist with pool special events and programs.
- Performs other duties and special projects as assigned.

EQUIPMENT/JOB LOCATION

- The employee will utilize the swimming pool equipment to include but not be limited to, pool vacuum and janitorial equipment.
- The employee may be exposed to chemicals used in the sanitizing of the swimming pool facilities and
- The employee may also be exposed to bodily fluids while performing rescues.
