The following policies are in effect for the McMinnville Fire Department Citizens Fire Academy. All citizens enrolling in the program are expected to follow these policies.

- 1) Classes will be three (3) hours in length beginning at 6:00 p.m. and ending at 9:00 p.m. All classes will start on time. Participants are encouraged to be on time for class start-up and when returning from breaks. At no time will you be taken to an actual emergency scene!
- 2) Attendance is an important part of the course; therefore, any student missing more than one (1) class will not receive a certificate at graduation.
- 3) In accordance with City policy, NO tobacco use is allowed inside Fire Department buildings or vehicles.
- 4) Your safety is the most important part of the program; therefore, all participants must follow the instructions given by their instructors.
