

REGULAR SESSION

May 28, 2019

The Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of McMinnville, Tennessee, met in regular session at its regular meeting place, City Hall, Tuesday, May 28, 2019, at approximately 7:00 p.m. Adequate public notice of the agenda was given by notices posted at City Hall, articles in the Southern Standard newspaper and news reports on the local radio stations. Present were: Mayor Ben Newman, Vice Mayor Ryle Chastain; Aldermen Kate Alsbrook, Everett Brock, Steve Harvey and Mike Neal. Absent: Alderman Rachel Kirby. Others present: City Administrator Nolan Ming; Shirley Durham, City Recorder; Tim Pirtle, City Attorney, and members of the news media and press.

The meeting was presided over by the Honorable Mayor Ben Newman, with Shirley Durham recording the action taken at the meeting.

CONSIDERATION OF MINUTES

Mayor Newman stated that written copies of the minutes of the regular session of May 14, 2019 had been sent to each member of the Board of Mayor and Aldermen previously. He asked if any member of the Board wished to make any corrections, additions or modifications to the minutes.

Motion was made by Mr. Chastain to dispense with the reading of the minutes and approve them as written. The motion was seconded by Mrs. Alsbrook and carried.

RECOGNITION OF VISITORS

Mayor Newman recognized Mr. Keith Hollingsworth, manager Super Rama Foods, 313 W. Morford Street, who stated he wanted to speak regarding the closing of West Main Street during this year's Main Street LIVE concerts. He said he was in favor of closing it one time just to see how it would affect his business with the street closed. He estimated his business would be down approximately 50% between 5:30 and 9:00. It would also cause issues with his parking lot. He said it worked real well last year with no complaints. He favored not closing the street.

COMMUNICATIONS

Motion was made by Mr. Neal to approve a request from Katie Kemezis, Director, Main Street McMinnville, for the City to provide twelve (12) roll-out waste containers with weekly pick-up and thirty-five (35) orange construction barrels for their 15th Annual Main Street LIVE! Summer Concert Series. The motion was seconded by Mr. Harvey and carried.

NEW BUSINESS

Motion was made by Mr. Chastain to confirm Mayor Newman's appointment of Dr. Jeff McKinley to another four-year term on the Board of Public Utilities. The motion was seconded by Mr. Brock and carried.
