

## CALLED SESSION

August 3, 2021

The Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of McMinnville, Tennessee, met Tuesday, August 3, 2021, at approximately 12:30 pm at City Hall for a Special Called Session pursuant to a letter of call dated July 28, 2021, issued by Mayor Ryle Chastain. Each Alderman signed the letter of call accepting the services of the call, waiving any and all irregularities. Present were: Mayor Ryle Chastain; Aldermen Stacey Harvey, Steve Harvey, Rachel Kirby, and Zach Sutton. Absent: Vice Mayor Everett Brock and Alderman Sally Brock. Others present: Nolan Ming, City Administrator; Shirley Durham, City Recorder; Tim Pirtle, City Attorney, and members of the press.

Mayor Chastain called the meeting to order and stated this was a special called session for the purpose to consider Ordinance No. 1816 and Ordinance No. 1818.

Ordinance No. 1816, an Ordinance of the City of McMinnville, Tennessee, to declare the certain property & real estate as surplus property; and to express the time when the ordinance shall become effective was introduced for second and final reading.

Motion was made by Stacey Harvey to pass Ordinance No. 1816 on second and final reading. The motion was seconded by Rachel Kirby and upon call of the roll Aldermen Stacey Harvey, Steve Harvey, Rachel Kirby, Zach Sutton, and Mayor Chastain voted aye. Voting nay: none. Motion carried.

Ordinance No. 1818, an Ordinance to authorize the City of McMinnville, Tennessee, to transfer and convey unto HOME – Homeless of McMinnville Effort all of its rights, title and interest in a parcel of real estate owned by the City of McMinnville as described on Warren County, Tennessee Property Tax Map No. 077 as Parcel 023.01, 6.17 acres on Sunset Point Road to be used to construct shelter and housing for the homeless on this parcel; to authorize the Mayor and Recorder to execute the deed for said parcel and for such other reasonable documents as may be necessary to consummate the transfer; and to set the time when this ordinance shall become effective was introduced for first reading.

Motion was made by Steve Harvey to pass Ordinance No. 1818 on first reading. The motion was seconded by Rachel Kirby and upon call of the roll Aldermen Stacey Harvey, Steve Harvey, Rachel Kirby, Zach Sutton, and Mayor Chastain voted aye. Voting nay: none. Motion carried.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned.
